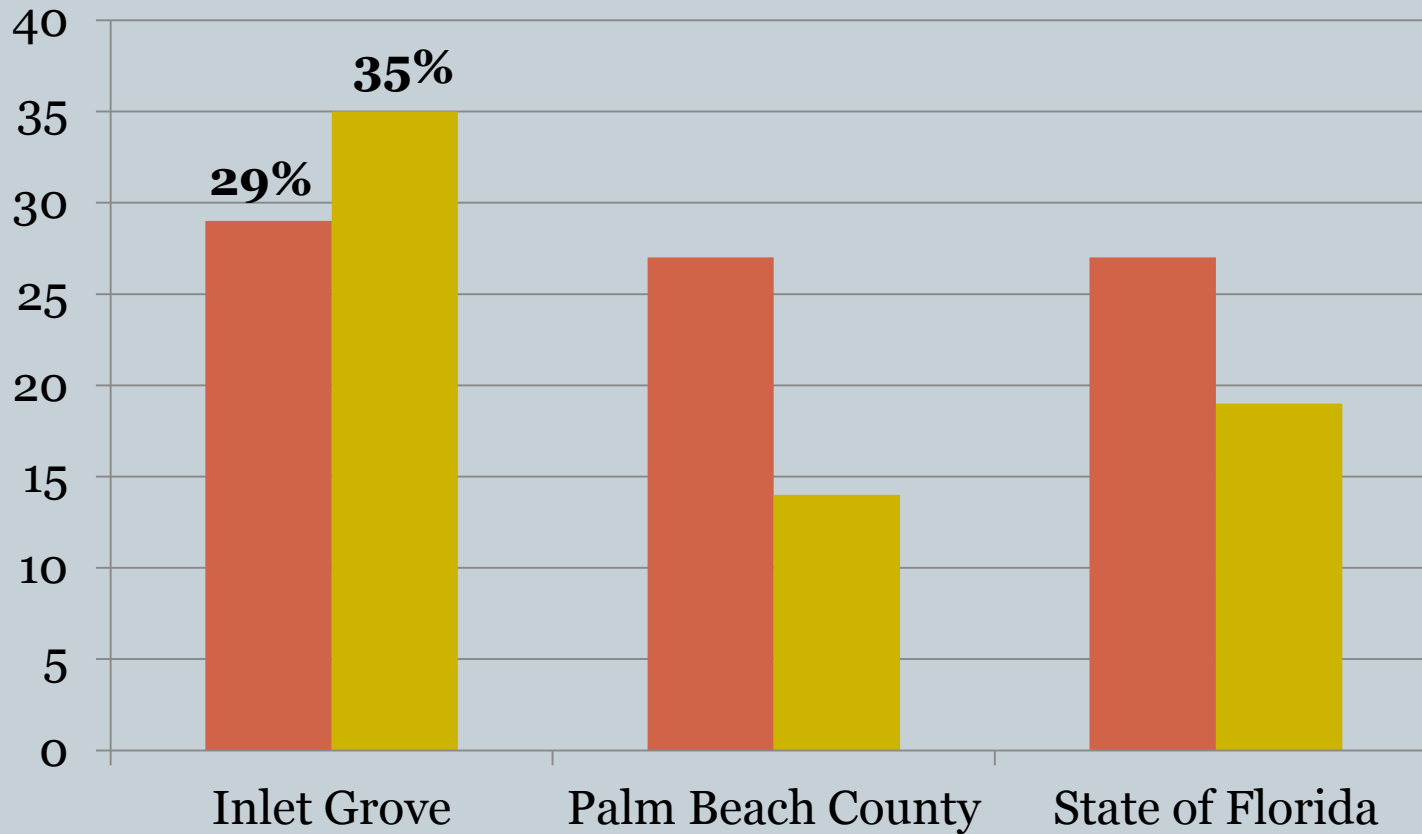


SY16 Fall FSA ELA

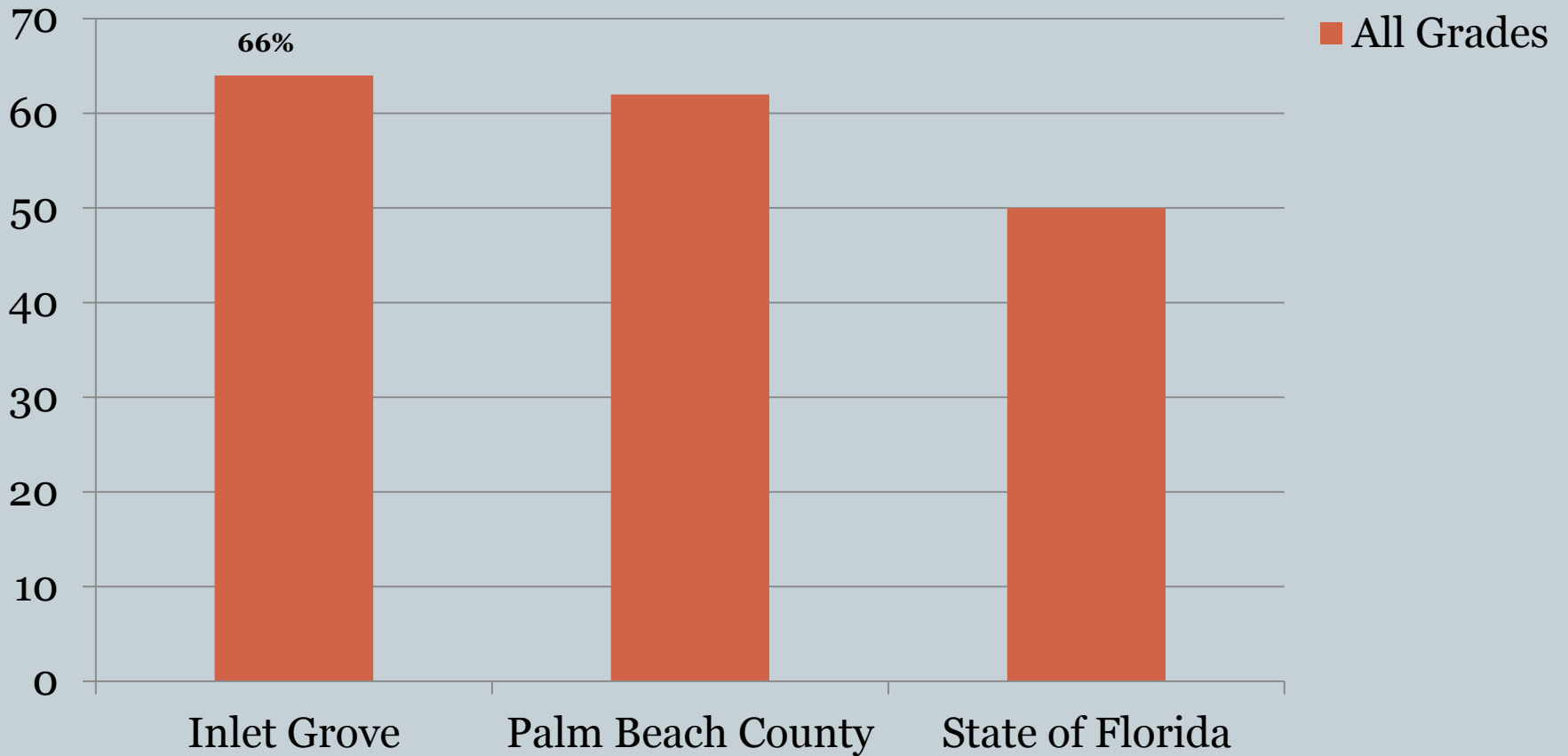




SY16 Winter Biology P.B.C. NGSSSS EOC

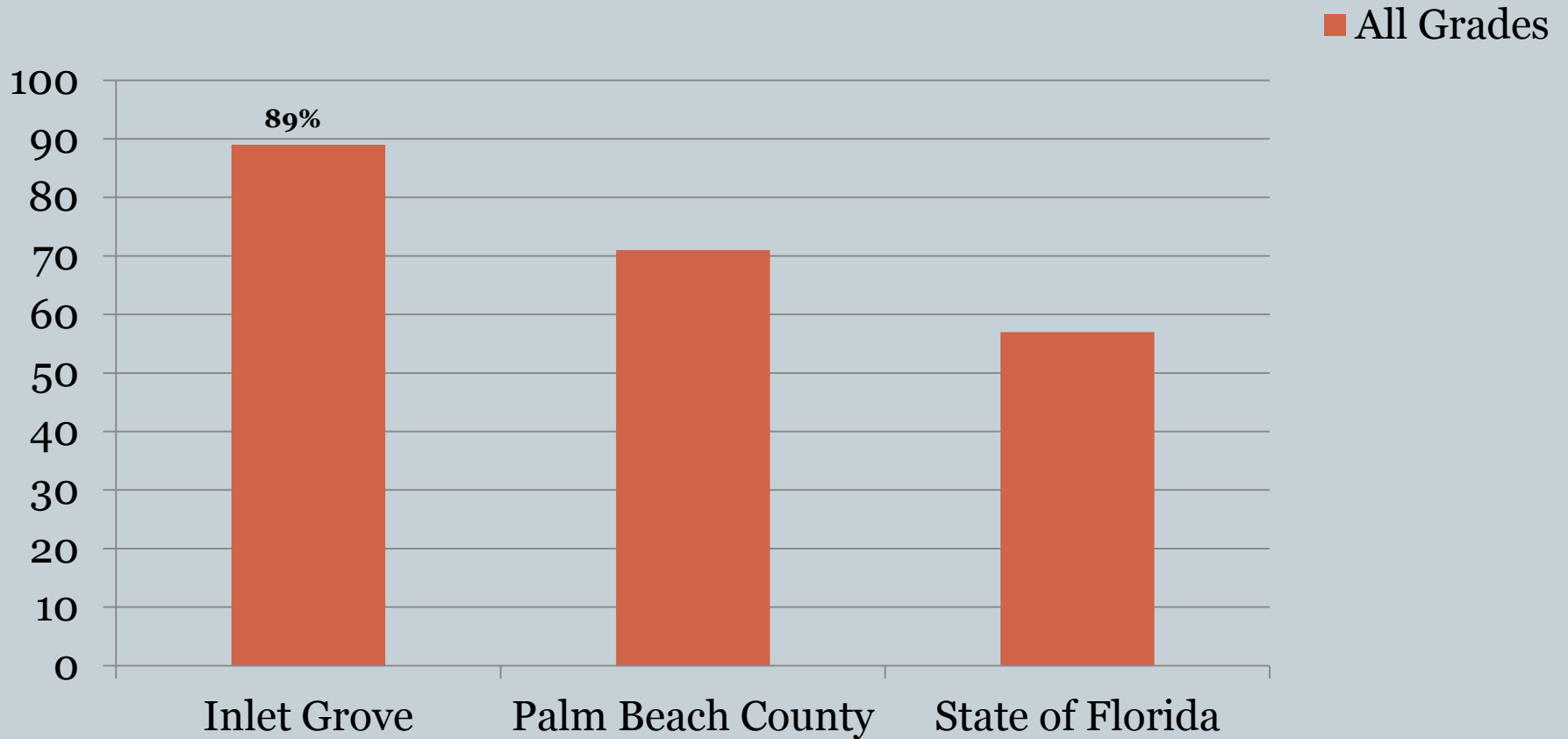




SY16 U.S. History P.B.C. NGSSSS EOC

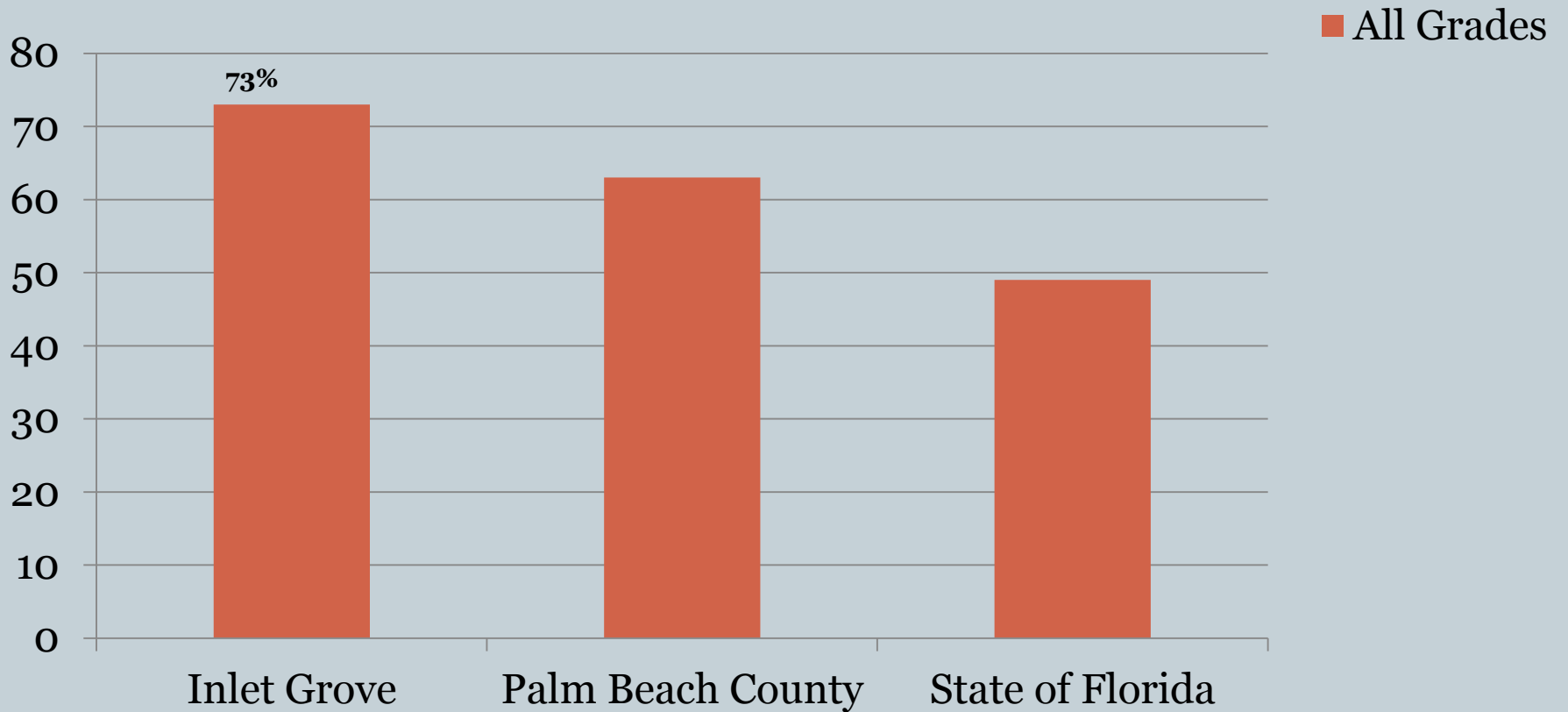




SY16 Winter Algebra II P.B.C. FSA EOC

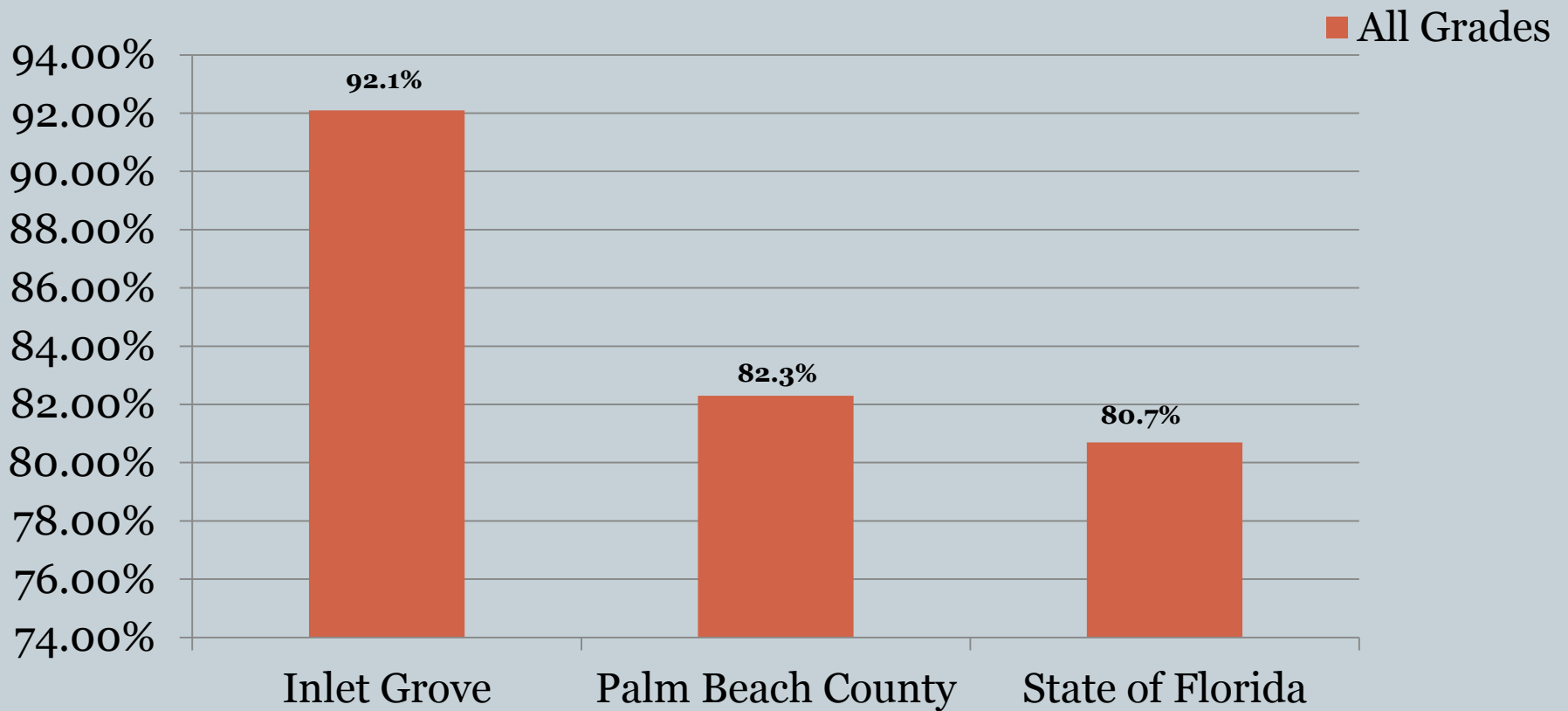




SY 2016 Graduation Rate



SY 2016 Federal High School Graduation Rates

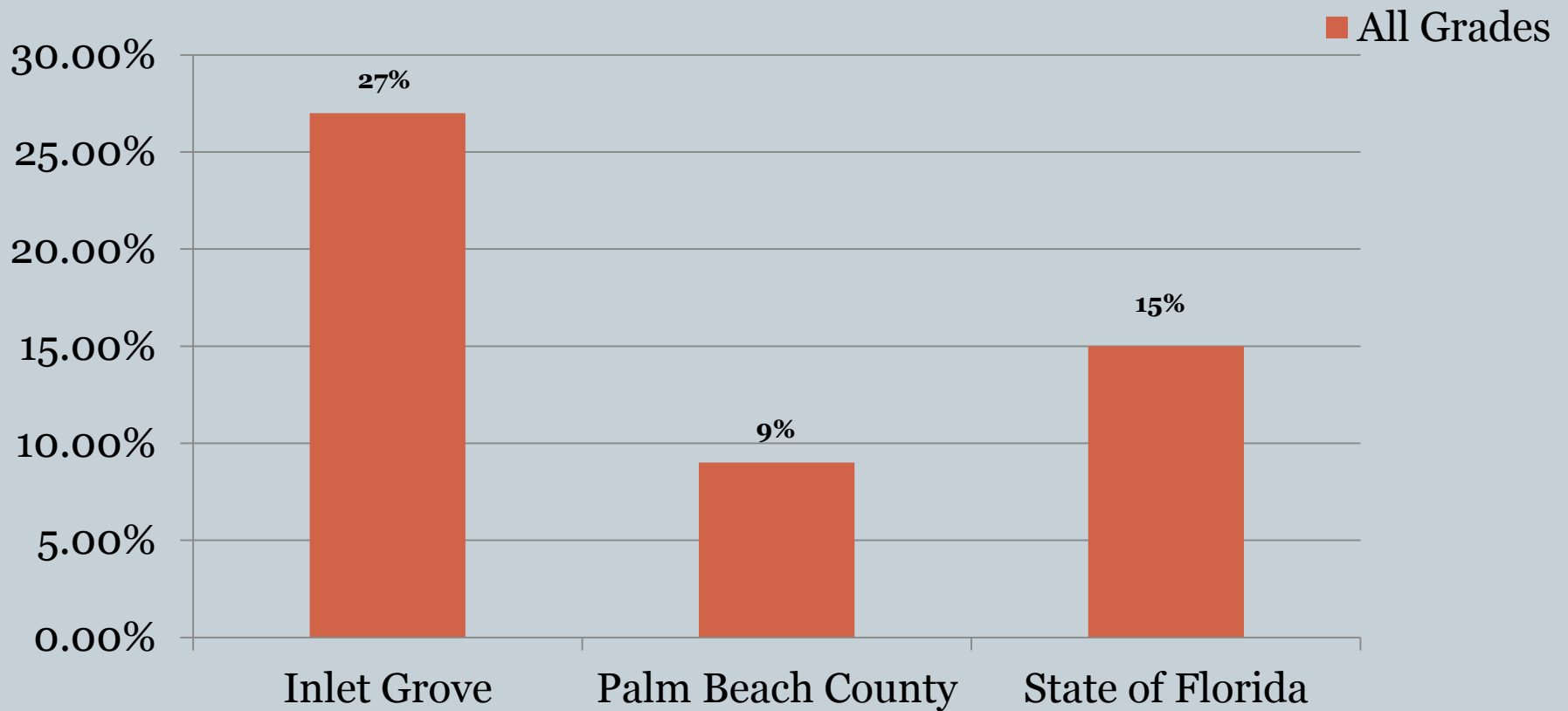




SY2017 Retakes Rate

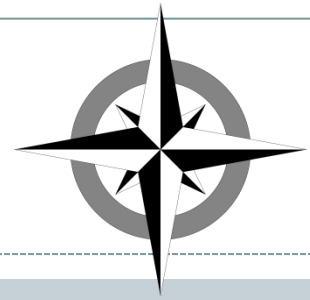
Career Academy Accomplishments

- The Culinary Academy catered school events including all advisory board meetings and provided white glove service for the Grand Opening of The Ben Carson Reading Room

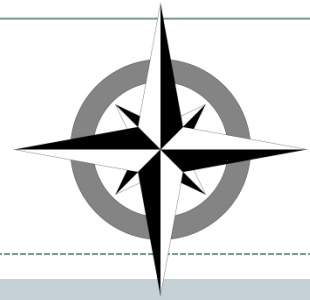


Plans For the Future

- To open a Biotechnology Program in partnership with Palm Beach State and Florida Atlantic University

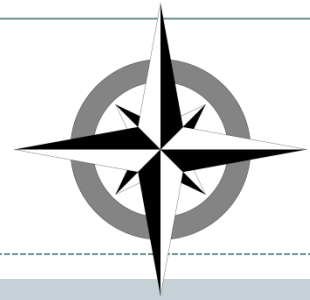
