**COMMUNITY SERVICE REQUIREMENTS AND INFORMATION**

ALL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE 75 COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS BY THE END OF THEIR SENIOR YEAR AT INLET GROVE COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL. THIS SHOULD INCLUDE AT LEAST 25 HOURS RELATED TO THEIR CAREER AREA.

**Listed below are some general facts and requirements regarding community service hours:**

- ❖ 75 community service hours are required for the Bright Futures 2010-Florida Academic Scholarship Award.
- ❖ Many colleges and universities require applicants to be involved in community service activities. Also, many employers require employees to be involved in community service activities.
- ❖ All community service hours must be documented on the Community Service Log Sheet. Each activity must be verified by the sponsor.
- ❖ All community service hours must be earned during grades 9-12.
- ❖ All community service hours must be submitted to and approved by the Community Service Coordinator at Inlet Grove Community High School.
- ❖ Community service involved volunteering time to a non-for-profit agency. Church activities are acceptable as long as they do not involve specific religious duties, such as, teaching Sunday school and preaching or speaking at church services.
- ❖ Baby-sitting, working in a parent's office, or helping a neighbor is not community service. Community service, which is completed as part of court probation proceeding, is not eligible for high school community service.
