

New COVID-19 Vaccination and Testing Site

To ensure vaccination and testing resources are available to Palm Beach County residents, the Department of Health – Palm Beach will now have an additional “FREE” COVID-19 vaccination and testing site open daily. This site is administering services seven (7) days a week with extended hours below, Friday, August 6th, 2021.

Open: Monday – Sunday; Time 9am – 7pm

Appointments are “NOT” necessary, and insurance is NOT required. For general questions regarding this location please call 850-583-2419.

Depending on the test you receive, test results can often take a number of days for you to get your results. Please keep in mind if you are traveling in the near future.

Regardless of vaccination status, if you experience COVID-19 symptoms you should keep your distance, be evaluated by your health care provider, and get tested.

COVID-19 Testing Consent for Students (2021-2022)

Inlet Grove Community High School and Beach Care Mobile Medical Services celebrate a continued partnership offering to conduct voluntary COVID-19 tests for students who present to the Inlet Grove Community High School clinic with symptoms of COVID-19, in an effort to protect the health, safety and welfare of students and staff of Inlet Grove Community High School. This testing is being conducted, to the extent these tests continue to be made available by Beach Care Mobile Medical services and will be provided at no cost to you.

COVID-19 Testing Information: The test that would be administered to your child is a rapid-antigen test. This test has been approved by the FDA under an emergency use authorization and involves the swabbing of your child's nasal passage in order to obtain a sample for testing. There are no risks and benefits with undergoing a diagnostic test for COVID-19 and there may be potential for false positive or false negative tests results. Additionally, the actual tests may cause slight discomfort to your child's nose or throat during the collection process and for a short period of time thereafter. You will be provided with the results of your child's test and it will be your responsibility to seek advice and treatment from your medical provider if necessary. You may also contact the school for additional information.

Student Privacy Information: The School Health program at Inlet Grove Community High School complies with all applicable federal and state privacy laws. All COVID-19 testing is confidential epidemiology information pursuant to section 381.0031, F.S. Test results are considered an educational record under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA). Generally, under FERPA your child's educational records may only be disclosed with your consent unless there is an applicable exception. One such exception is related to health or safety and allows for disclosure of appropriate education records to public health authorities in connection with a health or safety emergency.

Consent to Test: By your signature below, you certify that you have read and understood this COVID-19 Testing Consent. **More specifically, by signing below you:**

- Give you permission for your child to be tested for COVID-19;
- Release Inlet Grove Community High School from all liability as a result of testing;
- Understand that it is your reasonability to seek advice and treatment for your medical provider, if necessary;
- Understand that information regarding test results may be disclosed as allowed by applicable law; and;
- Understand that this testing may occur at multiple points throughout the 2021-2022 school year.

Please be advised that as a parent or guardian, you will be contacted by a nurse or administrator prior to any testing, even with this consent on file. For children in grades 9th – 12th, verbal authorization to proceed with testing will be accepted, with this consent on file, with the parent or guardian have the option of being present for testing.
