This role requires a strong understanding of special education laws, best practices, and a commitment to advocating for students with diverse learning needs. The ESE Contact portion of this role will involve coordinating ESE services and ensuring compliance with district and state regulations.

Responsibilities (ESE Teacher):

- Develop and implement Individualized Education Programs (IEPs) for students with disabilities, in collaboration with parents, administrators, related service providers, and students (when appropriate).
- Provide direct instruction to students with disabilities, utilizing a variety of evidence-based strategies and accommodations to address their individual learning needs.
- Adapt and modify curriculum and instructional materials to meet the needs of students with disabilities.
- Assess student progress regularly and maintain accurate records of student performance.
- Collaborate with general education teachers to provide inclusive educational experiences for students with disabilities.
- Communicate regularly with parents regarding student progress and IEP goals.
- Participate in IEP meetings and other related meetings.
- Maintain confidentiality of student information.
- Adhere to all federal, state, and local regulations related to special education.
- Supervise students in various settings, including classrooms, resource rooms, and school events.

Responsibilities (ESE Contact):

- Serve as the point of contact for ESE-related inquiries from parents, teachers, and administrators.
- Ensure compliance with all federal, state, and local regulations related to special education, including IDEA.
- Coordinate the referral and evaluation process for students suspected of having disabilities.
- Maintain accurate records of all ESE-related documentation, including IEPs, evaluations, and progress reports.
- Collaborate with school staff to provide professional development on special education topics.
- Serve as a liaison between the school and the district's ESE department.
- Monitor the implementation of IEPs and ensure that students are receiving appropriate services.
