This compact recognizes the shared responsibility of the school, home, and student for high student academic achievement.

School's Academic Goal:

If we provide targeted professional development for teachers to consistently implement research-based instructional strategies in Mathematics and ELA aligned to state standards and assessments, and regularly monitor student mastery using data tracking systems and instructional rounding feedback cycles, then student achievement will improve from 62% to 65% proficiency on the FAST ELA and 64% to 68% meeting proficiency on the Algebra 1 and Geometry EOC exams, supporting our continued high school graduation rate of 95%.

School's Family Involvement Goal:

If Inlet Grove Community High School secures parent and community partnerships to support the academic and social/emotional development of all students, then the reading proficiency will increase to 65% and mathematics to 68% as a leading indicator of improving high school graduation rate.
